"I am not a traditional preacher," shared Lovie, and the sighs of relief were almost audible, as if to say, "Thank you, Father. We are so tired of traditional preachers."

"I am a work in progress. Who will be honest with you? The people in your house, especially

your children. They don't know how to cover it up. They just tell it like it is.

"God will reveal mysteries to us and it starts with us. What's wrong with us? If you are one that sees everything that's wrong with everyone else, but not what is wrong with you, you will not be able to hear God.

"Your praise needs to match your trials. The Bible says, 'Many are the afflictions of the righteous.' If you want to reign with him, you must suffer with him. If you ever start blessing God and praising him, you'll forget about a lot of other stuff.

"Mat 27:55 says, 'And many women were there beholding afar off, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him.' If anyone can get a prayer through and touch Jesus, it's a woman. Jer 1:5 says, 'Before I formed you in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee.' Rom 9:11 tells us, 'For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth.' II Tim 1:9 tells us that we are saved and called with a holy calling, but not because of our works. Instead, it is because of God's purpose and God's grace -this purpose and grace that was given to us before the world began. I John 3:8 reminds us that the Son of God was manifested that he might destroy the works of the devil. Rom 8:28 tells us that what happens is never chance but on purpose. We must live our lives on purpose- on his purpose. Live on purpose. Live on purpose. Live on purpose. Don't let anyone or anything distract you. Live on purpose. Before you were born God had purpose for you.

"Promise children don't come quickly because the enemy is walking by the scene to stop them. The enemy will always do all possible to distract you from your purpose. You have a nation, a city, a family to save. Do what most women do not want to do – submit and live on purpose."

Because it is the truth that makes us free, anything less than the truth has the tendency of reducing the adherent to chains. People in denominations unwittingly enslave people with half-truths, thinking they are doing Almighty God a service. We are not to compromise the truth. We are not to embellish the truth. We are not to twist the truth. We are not to confuse the truth. To neglect part of the truth in doctrine is to invite trouble, strife, and disunity.

Have you ever felt like there are Calvinistic scriptures, or Wesleyan scriptures, or Catholic scriptures, or verses that really belong to another sect? This is a profound understanding. There are only Holy Bible scriptures, and they are all inspired by the Holy Spirit. We are forbidden to pick and choose. All scripture is given by inspiration of Almighty God, and not just the part we prefer. The scriptures do not contradict each other, but they compliment one another. The word "complement" means to complete or make perfect. Relevant scripture is not to be feared or shied away from. It is these passages that complete or make perfect the doctrine you are concerned with. (Cont. on pg 6)

This is helpful, for it keeps a person from error. To view all the scriptures as a whole is both wise and safe. To neglect some verses, leads to incomplete doctrine. The passages that each denomination wants to avoid are the very passages that complement and complete their doctrines, balance to what is otherwise out of Instead incorporating balance. complementary passages into their doctrines, denominations brassily go about explaining them away, as if we really don't need them. We treat some precepts as important and others as unimportant: as if, the Almighty should have consulted us, before he inspired the ones we consider important. In essence, these are "made of none effect" by sectarian doctrines. These things ought not to be. Do you see how utterly ridiculous it is to diminish any part of the Holy Bible? How can unity come, with phenomena such as these? It is quite presumptuous to tamper with wisdom that is established by the one who is wiser than we are.

the kingdom of God." That afternoon he and his wife took Patti out to lunch and shared with her in detail the vision they had for their church. They immediately invited Pattie to get more involved in the church's activities and programs.

A Year Later Unexpected Frustration

Less than a year later, Pattie was teaching Sunday school class for divorced women in her age group, and trying to help them gain a greater sense of self-esteem. Patti was not aware of Romans 8:19 that says, "all of creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own will but by the will of the One who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself would be set free from its bondage to decay and brought into the glorious freedom of the children of God."

At first, she was admired by all of the women and her class grew, but gradually her students became frustrated with her inability to comprehend or help them with the more painful issues and struggles in their daily lives. Pam in turn became very frustrated with their inability to grasp what she was teaching. She was confused and saddened that she could not help them walk with more confidence and discipline in their personal lives. Soon the women grew jealous and resentful.

Patti was not aware that there could be a purpose to this time of frustration. She was even less aware of why she should, or how she could appreciate the work of the Cross in her situation to redeem it. Therefore, she resigned as teacher, and maintained only one intimate friendship with a younger girl who had begun to visit the class and who responded to her like a little sister.

People and groups like these have helped bring about things like HB 954, the Fetal Pain Act, which states that the General Assembly of Georgia realizes an unborn child experiences pain after 20 weeks. This bill decreases the time that abortions are allowed in Georgia from 26 to

20 weeks. Halfway through the pregnancy abortions are now illegal. It also creates additional reporting requirements for physicians who perform or attempt to perform abortions, including the gestational age of the baby and the medical emergency that required the abortion. HB 954 is a huge step in the right direction.

"If I refuse to associate with, refuse to fellowship with another body of believers because they do not interpret scripture the same way I do, the love of Christ is not in me. I can strain with all my might to keep out every 'infraction' of how I think scripture should be interpreted, but, if I don not do it with the love of Christ, I am in grave error. Jesus spoke about this, 'Woe to you scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites... ...Blind guides. You strain at a gnat and swallow a camel. We all will err in interpretation of scripture. Let us err on the side of love. Love covers a multitude of sins.'

"If you're gonna love and work with folks, you better have some anointing, or the enemy will do you like he tried to do Jesus. Your Title will outweigh the kingdom your life. You cannot win against demons without the Holy Ghost. Luke 17:20-21 says, 'Now when he was asked

by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, he answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or "See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."

"We keep trying to look with our flesh for the things of God. We have to look with our spirit. The word is there, but it has to be activated. The kingdom of God is not what we call 'holiness.' Holiness is not what we say. Gal 5:22, that is holiness. John said, 'I baptize you with water to repentance but... ... He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.' You need the fire. Mark 16:15 says to go into all the world and preach the gospel. It says **go**, but we want to **stay** – stay in our church buildings. The proof of the kingdom in you are the signs mentioned in Mark 16:17. 'Believe' means to WALK in it. We are supposed to cast out devils, and too many church folks have devils in them. The serpents Jesus speaks of are also representative of the situations in your life. Most of us don't often come up against real serpents, but we all come up against the other kind. With no power the serpent will get you. You need some power in your life. Power!"

People were called up to the front for prayer – prayer to receive the Holy Ghost, prayer for healing and more.

"When Jesus places emphasis on scripture," Said Pastor Johnny, "as in Mat 6:33, you better pay attention. In the culture that Jesus lived in, repent meant the Pharisees had to change, to admit they were wrong and Jesus was right. If something is not allowed in heaven, there is no place for it in your life."

It is because we are in the end times. Think of the work we could accomplish together if not for the division. Brother Rick, when they reject you, forgive them and move on. Do not grow weary of well-doing. In John 17:20-24 Jesus explains it: that we should be one so that the world would believe that the Father sent him. Because of Jesus, when God sees me or any blood-bought child, he sees Jesus. While we are bickering, people are dropping off in hell. Unity starts with the shepherds. If they are not together, the people will not be together."

"Everything I do is about the kingdom," began Pastor Walker. "A divided house cannot stand. It may be sad that it is when we are in our most broken state that we can hear him the best.
