### On Prayer 92 Call to Prayer (Part Four)

It is my aim to help the reader of Battlefield News with some prayers aimed at the needs of post-modern people in our fast-paced, anxiety-ridden time. It is my desire to bring these things to followers of Jesus Christ via key thoughts, key scriptures and faith-building prayers based on the word of God, as well as other scriptures that give solid, concrete answers to life's dilemmas.

These prayers, for the most part, are about the things we share as humans who want to follow the Messiah. Their main focus is on spiritual growth, victory over personal problems and ministry to others. These are matters of great concern to our Heavenly Father as well as to us. Beyond building familiarity with the scriptures, these prayers are aimed at helping the follower of Yeshua to know Adonai (The Lord), since to know him is life eternal.

It is my aim to show you scriptures that, when you are lonely, bring the comfort of the Holy Spirit. They impart hope to those who are experiencing despair and grief.

God has promised that his word will not return to him void: 'so is my word that goes out of my mouth (rhema) – it will not return to me unfulfilled; but it will accomplish what I intend, and cause to succeed what I sent it to do' (Is 54:11 CJB).

When we return God's word to him through prayer, we receive his answers because the word of God is: "Quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb 4:12 KJV). For those readers whose Middle English is somewhat rusty, I quote from a more modern English version: "See the word of God is alive! It is at work and is sharper than any doubleedged sword - it cuts right through to where soul meets spirit and joints meet marrow, and it is quick to judge the inner reflections and attitudes of the heart" (Heb 4:12 JNT). As we learn to pray the word of God, our Creator will reveal the motives of our hearts to us and we learn how to pray within his will. God promises that his word will accomplish his will in our lives.

"Mere intellectual study of the word of God is not enough; there must be meditation upon it. The word of God must be revolved over and over in the mind with a constant looking to God and his Spirit to make that word a living thing in the heart. The power that is born of meditation on the word of God is the prayer which soars upward to God's listening ear." R. A. Torrey was a powerful man of prayer. That is why he wrote those words in *How to Pray* in the 19<sup>th</sup> century

George Mueller, another mighty man of prayer in Bristol, England in the 19<sup>th</sup> Century (1805 to 1898), would begin praying by reading **and meditating** on God's word until a prayer began to form itself inside him. Therefore, God, himself was the real author of the prayer, and God answered the prayer which he himself had inspired.

Mat 25:31-46, "When the son of man comes in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. No light show can compare to the effect had on a family when the alcoholic or drug addict father gets born again and is completely transformed. Some years ago the Lord lay on my heart that "the reason America is losing a generation is not because of a lack of churches, a lack of religion or a lack of programs; America is losing a generation because of a lack of the demonstration of the power of the Holy Spirit." And there it is. While one church bashes another and one minister is jealous of another ministry and they compete like children, America slides into the abyss. ### When our Titles Become **Bigger than out Towels**

I have seen too many times in the body of Christ people who get completely bent out of shape over titles. There are legitimate titles and by "legitimate," I mean those things that are grammatically correct (not politically correct). Most of us use them. They are a sign of respect. "Pastor" is a title. There are other grammatically correct titles as well. Titles should mean something. They should show recognition for an office held or a degree achieved.

If everyone has a title, however, titles begin to mean far less. In addition, there are many "titles" that are not actually titles. "Reverend" is not a legitimate title. Yet I see it in writing on church programs and in conversation. Have you every heard, "Reverend Martin Luther King? No! Reverend is not a title. Instead, what you see is the reverend Doctor Martin Luther King. "Doctor" is a legitimate title.

"Apostle" is not a title. It is a very valuable office in the body, but it is not a grammatically correct title. Can you find anywhere in the word of God where 'apostle" is used as a title? Have you ever seen Apostle Peter, Apostle Paul or Apostle John? No! I believe some people actually think it is there, but it is not. It is not a title. What you see is the apostle Paul or John the apostle. These men are actually real apostles. They were not called this in an honorary way. There are real apostles, but there are also many who claim that, but are not. It is beyond the scope of this article, however, to define what an apostle actually is.

"Prophet" is not a title. Once again, try to find anywhere in the word of God that uses it as a title. You will not see it. Instead, you see Elijah the prophet or the prophet Isaiah. Make no mistake, we need prophets and there are real prophets in the body of Christ, but it is a function; it is not a title. Calling someone "Apostle Womack" or "Prophet Bill Johnson" is like calling someone "Mechanic Womack" or "Store Manager Bill Johnson." We don't say, "Janitor John Phillips, instead we could say, "John Phillips the Janitor." We don't say "Plumber James Warren." We say the plumber James Warren."

"Missionary" is not a title; "teacher" is not a title; "evangelist" is not, nor is "elder."

There are people who insist everyone be addressed as "Brother" or "Sister." If someone is not a Catholic monk, then "Brother is not a legitimate title. If someone is not a nun, "Sister" is not a legitimate title. The use of "brother" and "sister," however, is very traditional as is the term "mother" for an older woman in a church, and is a little more acceptable, but not in print. Some have responded that we should call each other "brother" and "sister" because we are brothers and sisters in Christ. My answer to this has always been that I have a real brother and a real sister. Never in my life has either of them called me "Brother D. L." They just call me "D. L." And they are my actual siblings. Are we really brothers and sisters in Christ or not? Then we don't need those titles.

From what I have seen, in many cases, titles tend to be ego pumpers. We can show respect to one another without giving every last person some sort of title. If you have to, you can refer to a person as Mr. or Ms. (in the South, we have always said "miz," whether a woman was married or not).

If everyone has a title, then no one's title means anything. Let's reserve those titles for those people who have a legitimate title. Some examples of grammatically correct titles are Pastor, Chaplain, Bishop, Doctor, President, Secretary (I'm not talking about receptionists; everyone on the president's cabinet is a secretary, everyone who serves on the WBCA board of directors is a secretary; it is a title), any military rank (Private, Sergeant, Captain General) senator, Congressman and Officer.

In John 13:4-17, Jesus wrapped a towel around himself and began washing the feet of his disciples. He was teaching them real humility, not false humility, as we see when people talk badly about themselves. He also told them they must be able to wash one another's feet. Far too many of us have allowed our titles to become bigger than our towels. If the Lord himself can get down with a towel around his waist, wash the feet of those who followed him. We can do the same without insisting that people call us apostle, prophet, evangelist or some other title.

### **DL Ruins Everything**

This BFN Note is a response to something from the Jan 2021 edition of BFN. It is an amendment to something preached by many preachers, but it is a misinterpretation of scripture. Use it if you want to, but you are correcting people who don't appreciate it. Research was put into it, so you might use it.

The quote was from Is 10:27, "...the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing" (KJV). Many preachers say, "The anointing breaks the

#### **BFN Note**

The first thing that it is important to note is that the prophet was talking to the Israelites, not the Jews. The Israelites (the ten lost tribes of Israel dispersed throughout the world by the Assyrians) were exiled from the Northern Kingdom, the Kingdom of Israel by the Assyrians, but that empire did not conquer the nation of Y'hudah (Judah); that nation was conquered by Babylon.

The second and possibly more important thing to note is that scripture quoted so often that indicates that the anointing breaks the yoke is from the KJV. There are many people that will read no other Bible. It is a bit tragic that it is like that for some, because there are many biblical truths they will never understand. The KJV is one of the most fantastic English translations because it was completed in 1611 without the benefit of computers or hardly any sort of technology. It was translated from Hebrew and Greek into English by a team of 17th century biblical scholars. It is almost miraculous considering what they had to work with.

There are, however, some major translation problems with the King James. Everyone needs to have a copy of the KJV for several reasons, not the least of which is that the

Strong's Concordance is written for the King James. The wonderful thing about that is that the Strong's can be used to correct some of the KJV translation errors. The easiest way to overcome those translation errors is to have multiple translations to check the KJV

Let's investigate this scripture using some other translations because this particular misunderstanding is very common in the body of Christ.

Is 10:27 KJV: "And it shall come to pass... ...and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing."

Is 10:27 NKJV (New King James Version):

"And it shall come to pass... ...and the voke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil."

Do you see the subtle difference? The translation is closer to the actual meaning, but it is still not there.

Is 10:27 ESV (English Standard Version): "And in that day... ...and the yoke will be broken because of the fat."

You see we have gone from "anointing oil" to "fat." This is referring to the fatness of the neck of the oxen wearing the yoke because of its growth.

Now let's look at a much more recent translation:

Is 10:27 CJB (Complete Jewish [Messianic Jewish] Bible): "On that day his burden will fall from your shoulders, and his yoke from your neck; the yoke will be destroyed by your

Understand that the anointing may very well break the yoke, but that is not what the Is 10:27 scripture is saving.

(from pg 1) over again to be in unity. We are also told that sectarianism is a sin. For 500 years, since 1517, Protestants have been splintering into smaller and smaller groups. I Cor 1:10-13 tells us this is a sin. I Cor 3:1-4 concurs. I Cor 1:1-11 tells us not to show our differences to those in the world, but that is exactly what we do, especially on Face Book.

In John 17, The Lord prayed his longest recorded prayer in the Bible. He began by praying for himself, then his talmadim (disciples), but then he says, 'I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that they all may be one... ...in us that the world may know that you sent me.' This our savior prayed to the Father for. How can we say we love him if we do not work for this? We know that we are supposed to preach the gospel to all the unsaved, that they may come to know our Lord. We call this 'the Great Commission.' We are also told to be in unity with one another, to say the same things. I am calling this the second greatest commission. We cannot accomplish the first one effectively without working the second one.

"I could quote scripture from now until dawn about being in unity, but if you don't get out there and tell every pastor of every Christian Church, it won't matter what I quote. There are groups and alliances all over Georgia, all over the US, and all over the world who are working for unity in the body of Christ. In this part of North Georgia there is the Whole Body of Christ Alliance.

### What does it take for a body of believers to become allied with the WBCA?

This is a questions we in the WBCA have been asked many times. It takes making the statement, 'We believe we should stand with the WBCA,' It also requires that that church (pastor) make a commitment to work for unity and finally there are eight tenets we all believe (see first column, pg 8) and every Christian church must believe these as well to stand with the Alliance.

Are dues required? No, but donations for the Battlefield News are appreciated, as well as helping other churches and ministries as God directs you. We ask for a commitment and that the body of believers will actually do the work required to bring about unity in the body of Christ.

How many Churches have made this commitment? The WBCA is small for now. There are only 57 churches in seven counties.

"Col 3:12-15, Since God chose us to be his people, we must put on compassionate hearts, kindness, meekness and patience... ...as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must forgive. Most of all we need to clothe ourselves in love, which binds us in **perfect** harmony."



Pastor Grant Myerholtz of Mt Hebron Baptist Church and We Have a Hope Ministries

"In Eph 4:15 Paul writes to this church in Ephesus about being in unity, 'but, speaking the truth in love, [we] may grow up in all things into him who is the head – Christ' (NKJV). The church is as if it were made of Legos. Now Legos are the spawn of the devil. If you can step on one of these barefoot in the middle of the night and <u>not</u> cuss, you <u>are</u> a child of God. My son has used them since he was five. He is now 15. This little one is 'Me.' Me has been through some stuff, has seen some things. Me was uniquely formed, uniquely made. If Me wants to be better, Me has to get with 'We.' If Me is with We, then Me is not as selfish. When Me (single

Lego) gets with We (bag of Legos Pastor Grant is holding), then Me + We = what we can <u>**Be**</u> (Lego Jeep).

"When you have kids, you do things that you said you would never do. I asked my son how he did this and he said, 'Dad, first I read the instructions.' He reads the instructions so he knows where he is going, then he sorts out all 11,000 pieces. He said, 'I don't rush or try to force them to fit together. The last thing I do is

check the floor to make sure you won't step on any pieces.'

"The strongest pieces you never see. They are out of sight. Those pieces on the outside, the finishing pieces, are the pieces you see. Never forget that God spoke through Balaam's ass. When we get back to the heart of worship we will see that Me + We = Be. My prayer is that what I do not be about me, but about him. I told him, 'I will never get in the way of Me and You again. That is when my life changed.

"There is more power in the church house than in the white house. I don't like any of them. When John the Baptist saw Jesus, he said, 'I gotta decrease and he has to increase.' It's real simple. It takes a good theologian to mess it up and make it complicated. All I know is that he saved me and I am different today than before he did."

"The anointing on my life requires that I grow up. Unity is being in agreement. Can I get somebody to agree with me tonight? Pastor Mary has been through a lot, but she's still standing. Everybody has thought about quitting, but we may not have **quitting sense.** If we are defeated, in the eyes of the world it is a defeated Jesus

"I asked God, 'Why are you taking me through this troubled water?' He answered me, 'because your enemies can't swim. 'How does a python kill its prey? It will squeeze it to death and the process is very slow. That is how the enemy tries to kill you.

"In John5:7 the waters at the pool at Beit-Zada (Bethesda) were troubled. God said there are troubled waters in this place. I'm not here to have church; I brought church with me. God is here waiting on you because the water is troubled. Did Jesus not take all sickness to the cross? David Lyles the minister of Victory Deliverance Center

"God called his people to live in unity with one another," David Lyles the minister of Victory Deliverance Center told the people at Christ the King on Friday the fifth night of the seven-day revival in October of 2020, "and do all things in love. We end up hurting each other, which is ultimately destroys unity if it persists and that is Satan's goal. Let's look at six verses God gave us from his word about unity:

"1: I Cor 1:10 says, 'Now I beseech you, brethren... ...that there be no division among you...' (KJV).

"2: II Cor 13:11 tells us, 'Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one

another, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you' (ESV).

**"3:** Acts 4:31 illustrates the power in unity, 'As they prayed, the place where they were gathered shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness' (NAB).

"4: Eph 4:29-30 says, 'Let no harmful language come from your mouth, only good words... ...that will benefit those who hear them. Don't cause grief to God's Ruakh HaKodesh (Holy Spirit) for he has stamped you as his property until the day of final redemption' (JNT). We can grieve the Holy Spirit through our actions. Let's pray for one another.

"5: In John 13:34-35, the lord told us, 'A new command I give you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are my disciples...' (NKJV). He did not say to love your neighbor as your self; that was already commanded. His new commandment was much more difficult: 'as I have loved you.

"6: Col 3:13-14 shows us unity in action: 'Bear with one another, if anyone has a complaint against someone else, forgive him. Indeed, just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must forgive. Above all these things, clothe yourself with love, which binds everything together perfectly."



Rabbi David Otero

"Tonight in unity," Rabbi David Otero of Tzur Yisrael (Rock of Israel) told the people at Christ the King at the fifth installment of the October 2020 seven-day revival, "we went back to the heart of worship and our Father sees us as little children

"Sister Lydia, my family comes from Cuba and socialism is not just a Soviet system, but a demonic spirit coming against Meshiakh. Sometimes we only appreciate things when they're gone. This (he held up the Bible) speaks of Messiah, not just to the individual, but to the whole world.

"The core of what this is about is unity. We are seeing the body become more of a structure and not just business or service. We have many denominations, so where is the body? Each one of us is part of the army of Adonai, so he will bring us together, but not necessarily under the best of circumstances. In the book of Acts, they gathered in homes under great persecution. Today, still many churches are not open. People will go to Costco or Wal-Mart, but they will not come to worship. They give way to fear and not to the King of kings. We come together by choice, not because we have to. God wants that shalom to be in his body. He called us here to stand and declare the glory of the Lord.

"Right now in the middle of an election and pandemic, the enemy wants to hinder the work of the body. Why is this word so important? It is important because it is the testimony of the Messiah from the very beginning of the book to the end. There's something I found in Genesis.

It is Gen 6:5-7, 'The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth... ...and the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth... "... I will blot out man... ... for I am sorry that I made them." The Hebrew says, I will blot out the man. This is a clue to the coming of Messiah that he would be blotted out. Dan 9:26 says the Messiah will be cut off (blotted out), but not for himself. When he returns all the earth will belong to him.

"But while we wait for his return, we pray for one another and work to bring the body back into unity. For many of us, especially this year (2020), there are things we must address. If any one here has any doubt at all who Jesus is, come up here right now."



The reverend James Mays

"Gen 2:24," began the reverend James Mays of Sons of Light at Victory Deliverance Center on Saturday of the seven-day revival, "says, 'a man shall leave his father and his mother and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh' (KJV). We need to live together in unity until death do us part just like Adam and Eve, Michael and Jody Bennett, Rick and Neyda Hempton, Larry and Nina Percifield and James and Theresa Walker. When one falls, both fall if they are in disunity. If they are in unity, if one falls, the other will pick them up. Stop watching the bad news, the tell-lie-vision and get into the Bible. A journey of a thousand miles is taken one step at a time. When one part of the body suffer, every part suffers. When one rejoices, the others rejoice.

"In I Cor 12:27-28 it says, 'Now you are Christ's body and individual parts of it. Some people God has designated in the community of Messiah (the Church) to be first, apostles, second, prophets; third, teachers, then mighty deeds; then gifts of healing, assistance, administration and varieties of tongues' (NAB). A big reason why many fail is because they try to do all by themselves. In unification is power. Fill yourself with the word. Jesus died on the cross for our unity too."



**Pastor Roger Williams of Inner Fountain** 

"There is a fantastic story in Acts 16:22-29," Pastor Roger Williams shared with the people at Victory Deliverance on the sixth installment of the October 2020 seven-day revival. "Paul and Silas had their clothes torn off, were beaten and were placed in the inner part of the prison. What do you do when you find yourself between a rock and a hard place? They were in the darkness of the prison talking in the darkness and began to praise God and sing hymns in complete darkness.

"I can't do it by myself and neither can you. this

is not a superman job, but one can chase 1000 and two can chase 10,000.

"Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God at around midnight. 'While the other prisoners listened attentively, suddenly there was a violent earthquake which shook the prison to its foundations, all the doors flew open and everyone's chains came loose' (Acts 16:25-26 JNT). When God moves in your life, the devil has to loose you.

"The three young Hebrew men in Daniel Chapter 3, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah (Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-Nego) trusted God. With the presence of the Lord, there is joy and peace forever more. You did not call yourself, God called you. Touch your neighbor and say, 'Can we pray through this?' because God is calling us together."



Greg Brockman, author and former member board of directors WBCA

"This is the ugliest shirt I've ever seen" Greg Brockman told the people at Living Hope on the last night of the Seven-day revival in October 2020. "I told Crystal I had to have it because it reminds me of the way God is. We say, 'Look at that drug addict. He is ugly. We must come into unity about that. We need to set a value on people and things that we regard as ugly. I'm not talking about church folks, but about those who smell bad, those who might have been drinking, drug addicts, prostitutes, not church folks. Alcohol and drugs really steal beauty in so many ways, especially from women. There was a lady on heroine that I prayed over. I came into unity with her mama about her and into unity with God about her. Her mama did not see her as ugly. That was her baby.

"This drunk, homeless man over here has valuable experiences I never had, even beliefs I never experienced.

"I saw a pastor from an alphabet church (e.g. AME, FBH,TMN Church) and I thought nobody could be any further or different from me than he was. But he said, 'If we can't agree that it is wrong to kill little unborn babies, we can't agree on anything.' This black man said, 'as long as the lives of little black babies don't matter, black lives will **never** matter.'

"We have to see the value in those that are not so pretty or we're going down. In the 1830sthe Presbyterian Church of America divided over slavery. The Methodist church divided over slavery and the Baptist church did the same. That is why we now have the **Southern** Baptist church. They decided they were not gonna speak to each other anymore. Charles Finney refused to go into the south because he said. 'They have slaves; it is not possible for them to get saved.' If Finney would have come to the south, there may never have been a civil war. Relationships change things.

Those who stand with the WBCA don't make the mistake of believing that to be in unity, we must never disagree on anything. You do not see that even in nuclear families. Nor do we make the mistake of thinking we must all believe exactly the same thing. That will never happen.

We believe that there are eight principles that must be considered when establishing sound doctrine and criterion for unity. There may be a few more, but definitely not less nor significantly more, other wise we border on works of the law, rather than works of faith. They are:

1: Humans are born with a sin nature; all have sinned and without Christ, are worthy of Hell, not fit for Heaven.

2:Yeshua (Jesus) is the messiah, the spotless Lamb of God, and in fact, is God himself, the second member of the Godhead, not a second God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

3: Christ the Messiah was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin (Miryam also called Mary) and sinless.

4: Jesus (Yeshua) died on the cross for your sins

5: Almighty God the Father raised Messiah (Christ) from the dead on the third day.

6: Christ will return for his bride at the appointed time of the Father.

7: The Holy Bible is completely trustworthy, for it is inspired by the Holy Spirit.

8: Blatant sin (living in sin) is intolerable and the Community of Messiah (Church) must not tolerate it from its own.



"It is time for us to bend out knees? V<sub>8</sub> says we will receive power after we receive the Holy Ghost. You can storm the capital, but you have to do it on your knees. You can come against policies and executive orders, but you have to do it **on your knees**. We do have to prepare for war, but it is a different kind of war. If you can wait at the capital for hours, why can you not stay on your knees for one hour?

"In I Sam 8:3, we see that Sh'mu'el's (Samuel's) sons Yo'el and Aviyah did not follow in the footsteps of their father, but were corrupt. The elders of Israel discussed it and, instead of asking for godly judges, asked for a 'king to judge us like all the other nations.' Was Israel supposed to be like all the other nations? Only two nations in the history of the world were formed based on God and his principles: Israel and the USA. God told Samuel, 'it is not you they are rejecting; they are rejecting me. They do not want me to be king over them' (I Sam 8:7 CJB). The people fired God. Donald Trump said, 'You're fired!'

"In Mark7:1-2," continued Pastor Dale, the P'rushim (Pharisees), who were the holier-thanthou church folks of the day, noticed that the Lord's talmidim (disciples) ate without performing the n'tilat yadayim, or ceremonial hand washing, they found fault with them. The n'tilat yadayim was not part of the law, but simply a tradition of the elders, which most Jews observed. The P'rushim were looking for something to find fault with. They had come all the way from Jerusalem for just that. It was the first year of Yeshua's ministry, but they had already heard about this revolutionary

"They purposefully brought this up to Jesus. In V<sub>5</sub>, they asked him, 'Why do your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?'

"He called them hypocrites in V<sub>6</sub> when he said, 'Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. And in vain they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men" (Is 29:13 NKJV). Jesus confronted this group of Pharisees, telling them, 'You depart from God's command and hold onto human tradition. Indeed, you have made a fine art of departing from God's command in order to keep your tradition! For Moshe (Moses) said, "Honor your father and your mother, and anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death." But you say, "If someone says to his father or mother, 'I have promised as a Korban (that is a gift to God) what I might have used to help you," then you no longer let him do anything for his father or mother. Thus with your tradition which you had handed down to you, you nullify the word of God' (Mark 7:8-13 JNT).

In those days some would declare their things to be dedicated to God as a sacrifice, even if they never actually performed that sacrifice. It was one of the traditions of the P'rushim (Pharisees). Then the Lord called all the people within earshot over to him where he was confronting the P'rushim and said, 'Hear me, all of you, and understand: there is nothing outside a person that by going into him can defile him, but the things that come out of a person are what defile him' (Mark 7:14-16 ESV).

A question at a private meal blossomed into a controversy that got the attention of the multitude. Therefore he called them all over and made a bold public statement, which liberated his listeners and infuriated the Pharisees.

"If you go to Hollywood, you will see a great sign on a large hill that says, "Hollywood." Jesus called them hypocrites, actors, like movie stars. Natzaret (Nazareth) sat on the edge of a hill like that big Hollywood sign. It overlooked a Roman army base.

"In I Cor 13 Paul tells about love. In the Greek it s agape, to love in a social or moral sense, to love unconditionally. The whole church is about love. Paul says, 'If I speak in the tongues of men and angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy... ...a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing' (I Cor 13:1-2 NIV). Everything Jesus said, he said with love. Besides Jesus, only a mother can call you a viper with love. Paul said, 'And now these remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love' (I Cor 13:13 NIV).

"The most quoted version of the Bible is not the KJV, NKJV, NIV or the ESV; it is the ITV. It is the 'I think' version.

So many of the things people quote from the Bible are not actually in the Bible: 'God will never give you more than you can handle.' Some people believe it's in there, but it is not. I Cor 10:13 does not say that at all. 'As a man thinketh so is he.' Prov 23:7 does **not** say that; read it again.

"After the incident with the Pharisees, Jesus left the Galil (Galilee). He went to the region of Tzor (Tyre) and Tzidon (Sidon), where he encountered a Syro-Phoenician woman whose daughter had an unclean spirit. When she asked him to deliver her daughter, he insulted her, 'Let the children be filled first, for it is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs'(Mark 7:27 NKJV). Many people would've been offended and stomped off, but she humbled herself and answered, 'Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs under the table eat from the children's crumbs.' He cast the demon out right then. He healed the deaf and the mute and all that came. He told them to tell no one, but they told everyone. Reverse psychology?

"People in those days and even now, people in third world countries do not automatically run to the doctor when they are ill. They go to the Lord. They go to the church, to the preacher. Those people see far more real miracles than we do. In that respect, they are many miles ahead of us.

Be patient to those around you, especially the babies in Christ. Get so much Jesus in you that there's no room for anything else. Talk to him all day until you go to bed and then dream about him.

"V<sub>14</sub>, 'Bless them which persecute you: bless, and do not curse.' Uh oh! You can't misinterpret that. Is it hard? Yes! Is the word of God hard? Yes, but we are **one body**. Too much of the church has rotten fruit in their baskets.

"V<sub>15</sub>, 'Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.' Has the church lost that? 'I should've gotten that, not them.' How can we rejoice with people if we have that mindset? Sometimes we need to just sit down and cry with them, go through it with them. That's how God wants the church to be. How are we gonna do that unless we have the mind of Christ, unless we are **one body**?

Then you are not part of the body; you are just playing a game. We cannot link arms with the world; we serve a different king. If Jesus is really your Lord, then you are my brother or sister."

"'Wisdom is with the aged and understanding in length of days.' Put on the full armor of God because people will make an assessment of Jesus based on us because we are all they can see. As Herman says, agape transcends the person regardless of race or religion. This is a pivotal time in our country. Many have no job; more than 300,000 have died from the Corona Virus, the world is having to face reality. Therefore they need us to be real and reaching people. If you have some age, you have some wisdom. I remember responding to something because of a thing I heard 30 years earlier from a teacher when I was in the second grade."

"In it were all kinds of four-footed animals, crawling creatures and wild birds. Then a voice came to him, "Get up, Kefa (Peter), slaughter and eat." But Kefa said, "No, Sir! Absolutely not! I have never eaten food that was unclean or treif" (torn by wild animals). The voice spoke to him a second time, "Stop treating as unclean what God had made clean" (JNT)



Pastor Johnny Sherwood was the main speaker

"This happened three times and the sheet was taken back up into Heaven. The Holy Spirit has to correct us sometimes and told Peter to go with the gentiles. Peter went with them to Caesarea to speak to Centurion Cornelius as the Holy Ghost had instructed him. Many people were waiting there for him. How can we not have unity if we are hearing this message because God opened it to everyone on Earth?

"Cornelius had seen the Jews praying at the ninth hour (3pm) and mimicked them. When our little nephews see Patsy and I pray they mimic us. In  $V_{29}$ , Kefa (Peter) asked why he was sent for and in  $V_{34}$  he addressed them. 'I now understand that God does not play favorites, but that whoever fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him, no matter what people he belongs to' (JNT) It is the big invitation to the Gentiles we see in  $V_{34-43}$ .

"In  $V_{44}$  the Holy Spirit fell on them. The Messianic Jews saw that the Holy Spirit fell on the Gentiles just as it had happened to them and the Gentile believers were baptized.

It took the gospel all that time to get up to the Gentiles, but it took almost no time for the gossipal to get back to Jerusalem. In Acts 11:4, Peter explained to the Jews what happened. In  $V_{17}$  he asked them, 'Who was I to stand in God's way?' The Holy Spirit will show us if we are not doing what he wants. God wants to fill us, but not for us; to give out to others, but we must yield to the Lord."

"I see Rock and the rest going out because there is not such an 'I' mentality. If you become a willing vessel, God will use you. Get a 'we' mentality."

"Neh 8:10 says, '...eat the fat and drink sweet wine and send portions to anyone who has nothing ready, for this day is holy to our Lord...' (ESV). They were celebrating the Feast of Trumpets. It was supposed to be a joyous time. Even though their world seemed to be falling apart, going crazy (Sound familiar?) they had just had the things of God explained to them and were going to be in communion with him. What a joy!

" $V_{10}$  continues, "...And do not be grieved for the joy of the Lord is your strength.' It was the Feast of Trumpets, also called Rosh Hashanah, the New Year. It was not a time to weep, but to celebrate. The people were instructed to celebrate the feast with eating drinking and sharing. That is what you call unity in the body. That joy he spoke of was undoubtedly the joy that the Lord has about us seeking to be in his presence, but in this context we see that Nehemiah was also talking about the joy that is found in seeking to know more about the Lord as well as seeking to know the Lord better. The byproduct of this is joy. Here the word 'strength' means place of safety, refuge, protection. Their refuge was God. They had built a wall and carried weapons, but he was their protection. This is faith and without it, we cannot please God.

"They kept watching the nightly news and watching their world fall apart. What do we do? Do we sit down and watch the news, watch our world crumble? Stop watching the news; the joy of the Lord is your strength.

"God did not tell us to come together once every three months. We are supposed to break bread with one another house to house. Our religiosity has made the intent of God of no effect. Communion was never supposed to be a wafer and a thimble of grape juice for five minutes. It is supposed to be a **meal** just like the **meal** Jesus and the boys shared at the last supper. It was a Seder, a celebration of Passover. That is what they were doing in the upper room that night. Do you wanna be healthy? Then take communion. Take it the way God intended: together, a meal with each other and with the Lord at the center."

From Talisman Christianity

Talisman Christianity: three years ago, this was a fresh word, straight from the Lord in a dream. I had never heard the term and asked the Lord, "Lord, what is a talisman?" He answered, "A talisman is like a piece jewelry that people wear to bring them good fortune and good luck."

When I looked it up the next morning, I found that is exactly what it means.

Then, I saw some quotes from A. W. Tozer addressing the symptoms of it, the lifelessness religion:

"The average church has so established itself organizationally and financially that God is simply no longer necessary to it. So entrenched is its authority and so stable are the religious habits of its members that God could withdraw himself completely from it, as He once withdrew the Sh'khinah from the Temple, and it could run on for years on its own momentum," Wrote Tozer.

He said "A community of believers must be composed of persons who have each met God in individual experience." He also said, "It is doubtful whether we can be Christian in anything unless we are Christian in everything." A.W. Tozer also wrote, "When true believers gather around a present Christ, it is all but impossible to have a poor meeting... ...but nothing can save a meeting held in the name of an absentee God... ...the Bible was never meant to replace God; rather, it was meant to lead us into the heart of God. Too many Christians stop with the text and never go on to experience the presence of God"

He wrote, that unintentionally, "The Scriptures have become for some a substitute for God. The Bible has become a barrier between them and God. 'We have our Bible,' they say with a certain amount of pride, 'and we need nothing more.' Its one thing to read about the new birth in the Bible and quite another thing to be born from above by the Spirit of the Living God."

We have all seen this in the body of Christ. How many times have you heard someone say that miracles, speaking in tongues and real prophecy only occurred in the first century and before, that God does not speak to us in the days we are now in? Jesus does speak to me; if you believe he doesn't speak to people any more, that is probably why you never hear him.

Jesus spoke to concerning this in a dream,

"Warn my people: they are wearing the name 'Christian' as though it were a talisman"

Look up: "Nehushtan" in your Bible. You will find that Moses received a revelation that healed. God told him to guild a serpent and lift it up so that people could see it and they would be healed of the deadly snakebites they were receiving. You will also discover that righteous King Hezekiah tore that thing down and busted it because the people had named it Nehushtan and burned incense to it. What had been a revelation in Moses' day was a talisman in Hezekiah's day. A revelation in one generation can be a talisman to another generation.

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord" (Acts 3:19 NKJV).

Anything we can do without the presence of God involved has the potential of becoming a talisman - a talisman act, a talisman song, a certain way we do things every time. Even the Bible its self can become a good luck charm, a Talisman. We are to worship God alone and never the **things** of God. We have all seen it; people will worship the Bible, they will worship the cross, the crown of thorns, even the nails. They will worship the altar, the podium, the

pulpit and even the church building. Sometimes the pastor is even worshiped.

Expose these things in our lives, Lord, that we may repent.

No more false finish lines! We need God to show up in power (Acts 2-4). So Be It

### A New Kind of Slavery: Communism

It is not my intent to offend, but I will not withhold truth in order to spare your feelings. Men have sold men into slavery since the beginning of time. (The vast majority of the men who died from the Confederacy never owned a slave in their life; they fought in place of those who had the money to buy their way out, as we have seen throughout history). When this is dismissed by people, it is a slap in the face to all the progress that has been made. Take some time and research what I've shared, there is so much more to the story, much more good stuff. Great Christian men like Martin Luther King Jr. understood this. The current movement is brought about by violent X-ideology based on Islamic/Marxist influence.

Communism is a more ancient system of oppression. Individual rights were first fought for by white, English-speaking men. Then oddly enough, instead of sharing those same rights, others had to fight for them. We have come a long way. 





### **Bible Knowledge**

I heard Hebrew goes from right to left, unlike Spanish, English, Russian and most other languages. I want to find out. I want to be able to read the Bible my cousin has with the Old testament written with Hebrew Character and the New Testament written with Greek Characters. 
